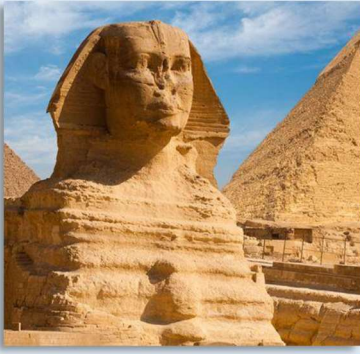


#### HALF DAY TOUR –GIZA PYRAMIDS AND SPHINX



Visit as the oldest known manmade structures on our planet and the only one to remain largely intact of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World; the great Khufu's (Cheops) pyramid. Continue to explore the rest of **Giza pyramids plateau** including Khafre's pyramid -Khufu's son, the second-largest pyramid on Giza site and Mecernes pyramid the smallest. Followed by a stop at the **Sphinx**, an ancient symbol of the pharos power, wisdom, and mysteries embodied in a huge sculpture of a pharaoh's head on a lion's body.

#### HALF DAY TOUR – MEMPHIS AND SAKKARA



Visit Memphis the ancient capital and current open air museum. Later continue to visit the step pyramids of Sakkara which is considered the first pyramid in Egypt.

#### HALF DAY TOUR SAINT SIMON "THE TANNER" MONASTERY



Many Coptic Christians populate this incredible "Garbage City" in Cairo. They collect the city's trash and sort out the recyclables to sell and make a living. The bags are in the streets, in the buildings, on the roofs, and balconies. A very different way of life most of us could never imagine. Special trip takes you to interesting Garbage City located inside Cairo. This place is not a historical attraction but behind it stands Monastery of Saint Samaan El Kharaz. It is also called Church of Saint Simon the Tanner which contains 7 churches and chapels hidden in a series of natural caves in Muqattam hills overlook City of Garbage.

#### HALF DAY TOUR –EL MOEZ STREET AND KHAN EL KALILI



Visit one of the biggest Open Islamic Museum in Cairo **El Moez Street** that has been recognized one of the greatest concentration of medieval architectural treasures in the Islamic world by United Nations study then move to **Khan El Khalili**, Cairo's old bazaar.

## HALF DAY - NATIONAL MUSEUM OF EGYPTIAN CIVILIZATION (NMEC)



The NMEC is the first of its kind in Egypt and the Arab world. It presents the full range of the richness and diversity of Egyptian civilization throughout the ages, from prehistoric times to the present day by focusing on its continuity and stability as demonstrated by its tangible and intangible heritage. The museum's exceptional collection includes the royal mummies, which are exhibited in a new interactive display using 21st century cutting-edge technology to go beneath the wrappings and reveal their secrets, in addition to shedding light on the rituals and religious beliefs surrounding mummification in ancient Egypt.

## FULL DAY TOUR –ISLAMIC CAIRO



Visit the **Citadel of Salah El Din** that was used as the seat of the Ruler for many centuries and witnessed many important events in the Egyptian History. Later some other important monuments were built inside the citadel among them the marvelous Alabaster **Mosque of Mohamed Ali**, in addition to many other museums.

Visit also the old and remarkable **Mosques of Sultan Hassan, Ibn Tolon and El Refaai**.

## FULL DAY TOUR –OLD COPTIC CAIRO



Coptic Cairo isn't only about Christian history, it's where you'll meet the three of Abrahamic religions in the same place.

Visit **Amr Ibn Al-Ass Mosque**, the first mosque built in Egypt.

Continue to the Roman Babylon fortress to go through the Christian history. It is believed that the Holy Family (the Child Jesus, St. Mary, and St. Joseph) visited this area and stayed at the site of **Saints Sergius and Bacchus Church** (Abu Serga). You will also visit **the hanging church of St. Mary** (El Muallaqa) and **St. George Church for Greek Orthodox** that were built above the fortress. Continue to the oldest existing Hebrew synagogue in Cairo, **Ben Ezra Synagogue**.

End the tour inside the ruins of the Roman fortress to visit the **Coptic Museum**. The Museum displays around 1600 items go back to different century in the Coptic History

Later continue to visit step pyramids of **Sakkara** which is considered as the first pyramid in Egypt.

#### FULL DAY TOUR MEMPHIS, SAKKARA AND DAHSHUR



Visit **Memphis** the ancient capital and current open air museum and then continue to visit step pyramids of **Sakkara** which is considered the first pyramid in Egypt and the only known pyramid from the 3rd Dynasty. Step to the 4th Dynasty to visit Senfru's remarkable pyramids; the Bent Pyramids and the Red Pyramid of **Dahshur**, which are considered the first two true pyramids in Egypt.



## FULL DAY TOUR –EGYPTIAN MUSEUM, THE CITADEL AND KHAN EL KHALILI BAZARS



Explore the treasures of **the Egyptian Museum** which housing more than 150'000 genuine antiquities covering almost 5,000 years of Egypt's history from the Old Kingdom through the Roman era.

## DAY TOUR TO ABDEEN MUSEUM



Abdeen museum complex in the capital of Egypt, Cairo. The building of the palace was completed in 1874. One of the richest palaces in the world is an official residence of the Egypt government. #### DAY TOUR TO PHARAONIC VILLAGE

On a motor boat, float down the Pharaonic Village's network of canals and encounter costumed characters recreating life in the ancient Egyptian era. #### OVER DAY TO AL FAYOUM



Enjoy Fayoum trip from Cairo visiting El Fayoum major sights Wadi El Rayan, Lake Qarun, Mudawara Mountain, Kom Aushim Museum and visit Tunis Village.

#### OVER DAY TO ISMAILIA

## OVER DAY ALEXANDRIA

During the tour, you will visit **the National Museum of Alexandria** that houses about 1'800 artifacts narrating the history of Alexandria throughout the ages, including the Ancient Egyptians', Roman, Coptic and Islamic eras. You will also visit the **Catacomb** and **Pombay Biller**. End the tour at the beautiful **Montazah Gardens** which contains a huge selection of trees and plants and some of them are quite rare.
