AUC actively seeks new scholarship opportunities to provide access to undergraduate students with outstanding qualifications and talents who come from diverse backgrounds and destinations around the globe.

Partial and full undergraduate scholarships are competitively awarded to students based on demonstrated financial need and merit.

SELECTION

Each type of scholarship has specific selection criteria that include, but are not limited to: nationality; major; type of school; high-school grade; outstanding academic, cultural and athletic qualifications; and demonstrated financial need.

ELIGIBILITY AND CRITERIA

Every year, AUC announces scholarship opportunities for Egyptian and international students. Some scholarships are offered to specific majors such as engineering, science, mathematics or economics, and some are open to any major. The offered scholarships are either funded by AUC or supported by individuals and corporations.
