

## Requirements for International Students Eligible to Pay Egyptian Student Tuition

International students who meet the admission requirements for Egyptian students and wish to pay the Egyptian student tuition amount must submit **originals** of the following documents.

Status	Required Documents
Egyptian Nationality	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A birth certificate</li><li>• If Egyptian nationality was acquired after birth, official evidence must submit to the Office of Admissions</li></ul>
International permanent residents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A certificate from the passport and residence department at the Ministry of Interior (El-Mogamaa) declaring that the student has had a permanent and continuous residence in Egypt for more than 10 consecutive years</li><li>• Proof showing that the entire family income is in Egyptian pounds (for example, an original of a commercial register form); this proof should be notarized</li><li>• A declaration from the father or guardian that the entire family income is in Egyptian pounds</li></ul>
International children of Egyptian divorced or widowed mothers	<p><b>Widowed Mothers:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Birth certificate of student</li><li>• Death certificate of father</li><li>• Evidence of permanent residence of the student with mother in Egypt</li></ul> <p><b>Divorced Mothers:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Birth certificate of student</li><li>• Divorce certificate</li><li>• A declaration from the mother stating that she is not remarried to the student's father after the divorce</li><li>• Evidence of permanent residence of the student with the mother in Egypt</li></ul>
