Fayyoun Day Trip FEB 27

The city of Fayyoun is the largest in its province and the capital of its governorate. Originally called Shedet in Ancient Egypt, Fayyoun has been known by many names over the years. The Greeks called it Crocodilopolis or Krocodilopolis, the Romans called it Arsinoë, and the Arabs gave it its current name, Madinat Al Fayyoun. One of Egypt's oldest cities, possibly the world's, Fayyoun was the seat of worship of the crocodile god Sobek.

Ain Sokhna, known as the 'hot springs,' refers to the nearby sulfur springs that flow from Gebel Ataqa, the Eastern Desert's northernmost mountain. Ain Sokhna is an ideal destination to enjoy the warm weather and the gentle waves of the Red Sea. On the way to Ain Sokhna, we will be visiting the Red Sea Monastery.

Mosque of Muhammad Ali and Felluca Lunch APR 3

The Mosque of Muhammad Ali in Cairo is also fondly referred to as the Alabaster Mosque. Thanks to its outstanding beauty, it is the most visited mosque in Egypt – sometimes referred to as the City of Minarets. The mosque is situated in Cairo Citadel and was commissioned by Muhammad Ali Pasha between 1830 and 1848.



El Tahra Palace APR 10

El Tahra Palace is located in Cairo and was designed by Antonio Lasciac. It was mainly built for Princess Amina, daughter of Khedive Ismail and mother of Mohamed Taher Pasha. The palace was built in the 'Italianate Palazzo' style.



Hurghada Trip MAY 27 - 30

Hurghada is a city in the Red Sea governorate of Egypt. Located on the Red Sea coast, Hurghada is one of the country's main tourist centers. It is home to some of the rarest marine life in the world, as well as the largest number of coral reefs. The city offers a variety of water sports centers for diving, snorkeling and wind and kite surfing.
