

AUC Faculty Orientation Survey Evaluation Report Fall 2022

The Office of Strategy Management and Institutional Effectiveness



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Introduction

The faculty orientation survey was designed and administered by the Office of Strategy Management and Institutional Effectiveness (SMIE) in collaboration with the Office of the Provost. The survey was administered in two consecutive sub-surveys to boost response rates: the first evaluated the first two days of the orientation, and the second assessed the remaining days (three to six) along with the overall experience. This report combines faculty responses to both surveys to provide an aggregate analysis of the Fall 2022 faculty orientation experiences.

Administrative Summary

First Survey: Days 1-2

The Office of the Provost provided the population list of 40 newly-hired faculty members. They received the survey invitation on the second day of the Fall 2022 orientation (August 25th, 2022). A total of 21 responses were received, representing a response rate of 53%.1

Second Survey: Days 3-6

Invitations to the second survey were sent on the final day of the orientation (August 31st, 2022). A total of 12 responses were received, representing a response rate of 30%.



Overall Orientation Experiences


Overall Usefulness & Organization

All respondents are satisfied with the organization and usefulness of the orientation (100% overall satisfaction, at different percentage sums of 'excellent' and 'good'). In line with last year's results, there are no dissatisfaction rates (i.e., no respondents indicated it was 'poor' or 'very poor').



The high satisfaction levels correspond to high weighted averages, with the event organization receiving a slightly higher weight (4.75) than the usefulness (4.73).²

Overall Satisfaction with Orientation (WA)






Institutional Support

All respondents are satisfied with the institutional support received, whether by the Office of the Provost (92% very satisfied, 8% satisfied) or respective academic departments (92% very satisfied, 8% satisfied). In line with last year's results, there were no neutral or dissatisfied respondents.



Satisfaction with Institutional Support (WA)

Respondents' satisfaction with institutional support is reflected in the high weights (4.92) across both dimensions.



Day-to-Day Evaluations: Usefulness & Engagement of Sessions³

Day 1

Overall, respondents found the Day 1 sessions more useful than engaging. Research funding was the most useful (4.65) and second-most engaging (3.85) session. The least useful (3.40) and engaging (2.50) was the Academic Freedom, FERPA, and OIE session.





Library Services was the most useful (4.5) session, and the most engaging was the Information and Cybersecurity session (4.21), although it was the least useful (4.11). Except for the Information and Cybersecurity session, respondents found Day 2 sessions to be more useful than engaging.⁴





The most useful session was the Departmental and School Orientation (4.58), and the least useful was the CLT Teaching@AUC Certificate and Blackboard Orientation (4.11). Meanwhile, respondents found the CLT Orientation to be the most engaging (4.45) and FILT Kick-off to be the least engaging (4.11). It is important to note that all sessions received relatively high weights (above 4.0), reflecting general satisfaction.



Respondents were generally satisfied with Day 4, with relatively high weights across all dimensions (above 4.0). Travel and Business Support was the most useful session (4.6), whereas Housing and Transportation was the least useful (4.09). In terms of engagement, respondents were mostly engaged in the Handling Student Concerns session (4.36) and least engaged in the HR Services and Benefits session (4.08).



Respondents were generally satisfied with Day 5, with relatively high weights across all dimensions (above 4.0). The Annual Faculty Reports and E-Repertoire System session was the most useful (4.64), and the CSW Counseling and Accommodations session was the most engaging (4.50). On the other hand, the least useful session was the Faculty Mentorship (4.10), and the least engaging were both the Faculty Mentorship (4.00) and Personal Health and Wellbeing (4.00) sessions.



The most useful and engaging was the US Embassy session (5.00), followed by the Core Curriculum and CBL session, which respondents found slightly more useful (4.55) than engaging (4.45). The Safety and Security session was the least useful and engaging (4.33) in respondents' views, although all aspects received relatively high weights (above 4.0).
