EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

INTRODUCTION

The purpose of the Graduate Student Exit Survey is to assess opinions of graduate students about their experience at AUC. The Graduate Student Exit Survey was developed by the Office of Data Analytics and Institutional Research (DAIR) and the Office of Graduate Studies.

DAIR emailed the survey invitations to 287 graduate students on Jan 10th, 2018. The survey remained accessible until Feb 7th, 2018, and one email reminder was sent throughout this period. Upon closing the survey, **146** students had completed it, for a response rate of about 50%.

METHODOLOGY AND ORGANIZATION OF THE REPORT

This report consists of four parts:

Part II: Questions regarding graduate students' academic experience, in addition to the overall students' rating to some academic aspects presented as frequencies and charts

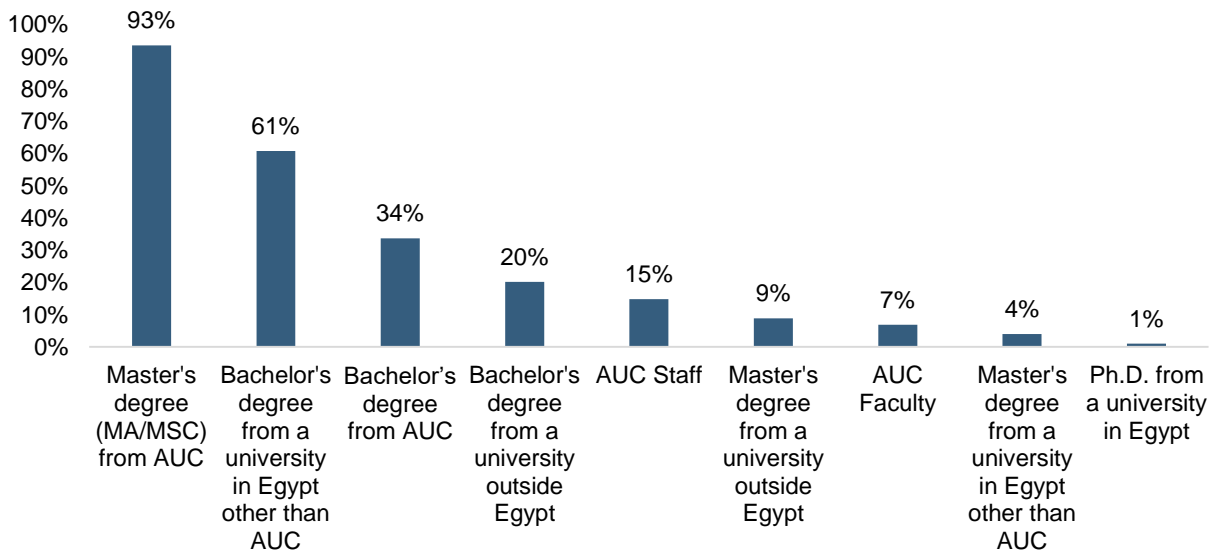

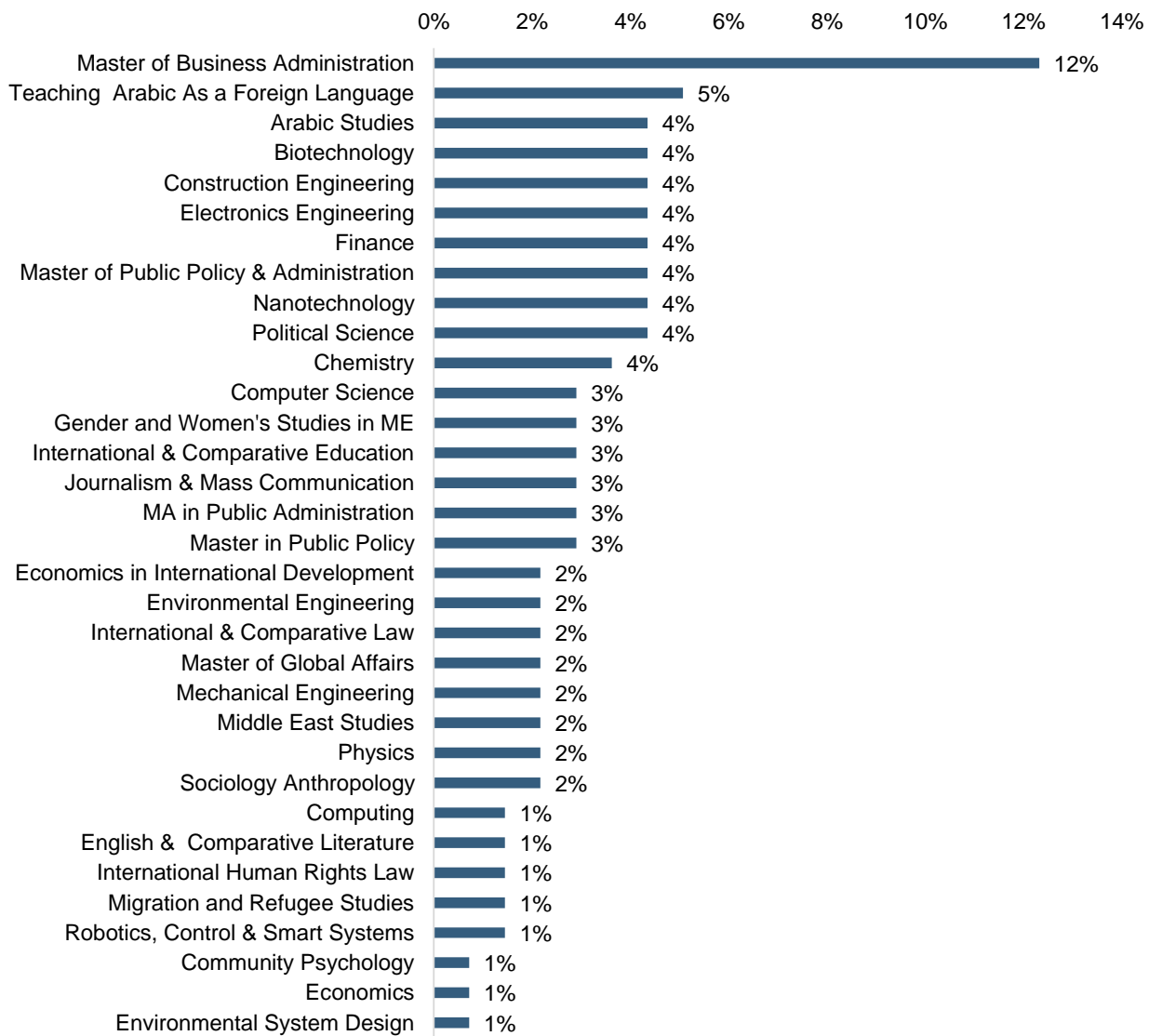

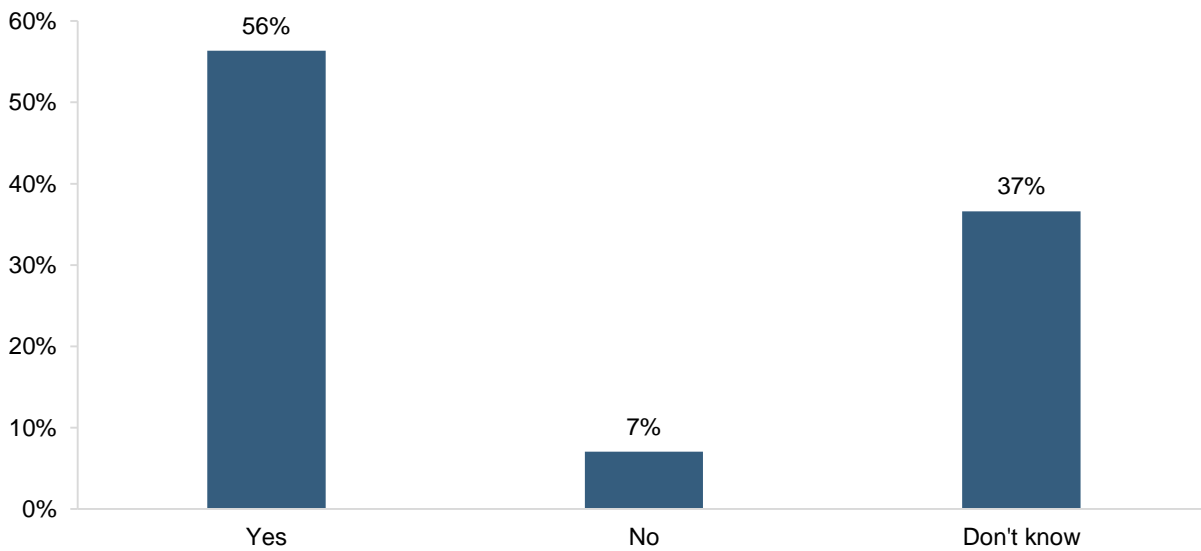

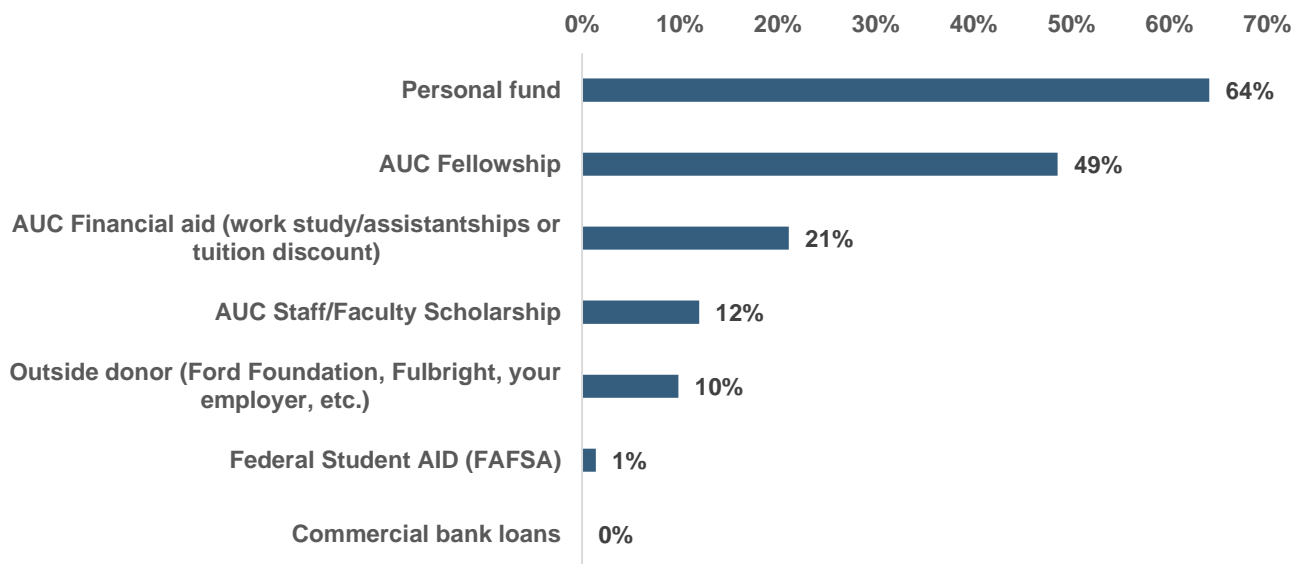

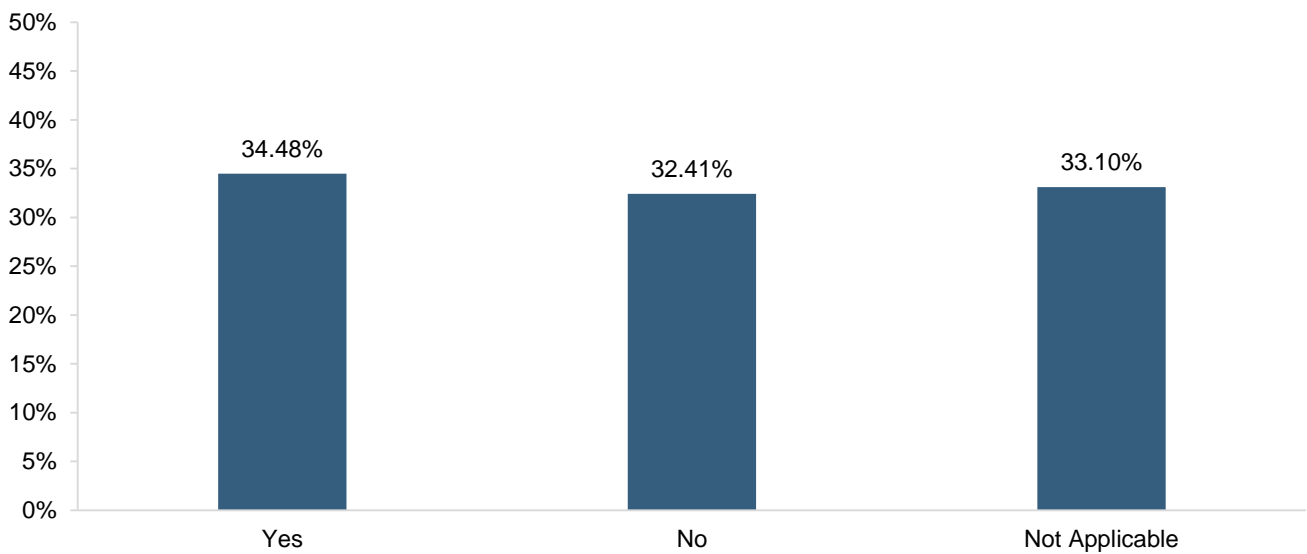

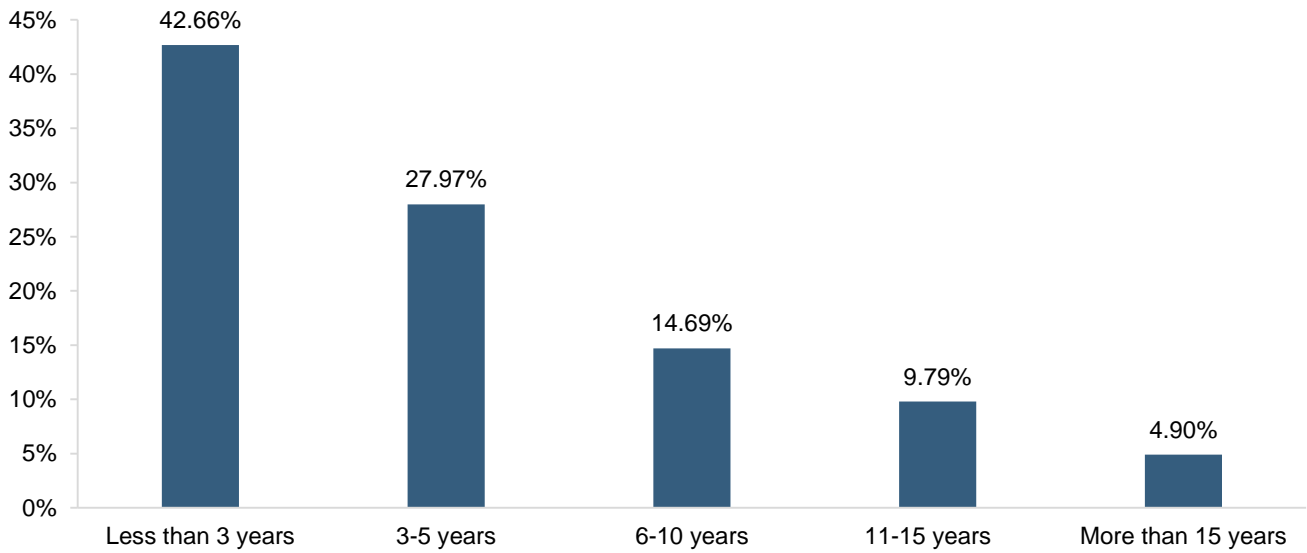
Q14: Has your AUC graduate degree had a positive impact on your salary?

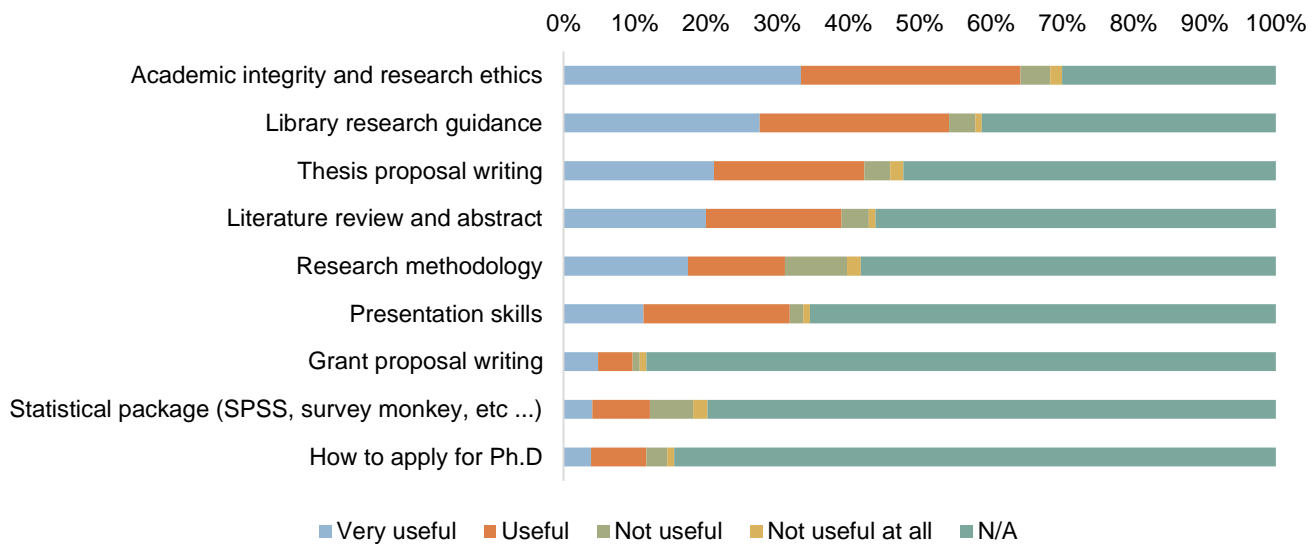

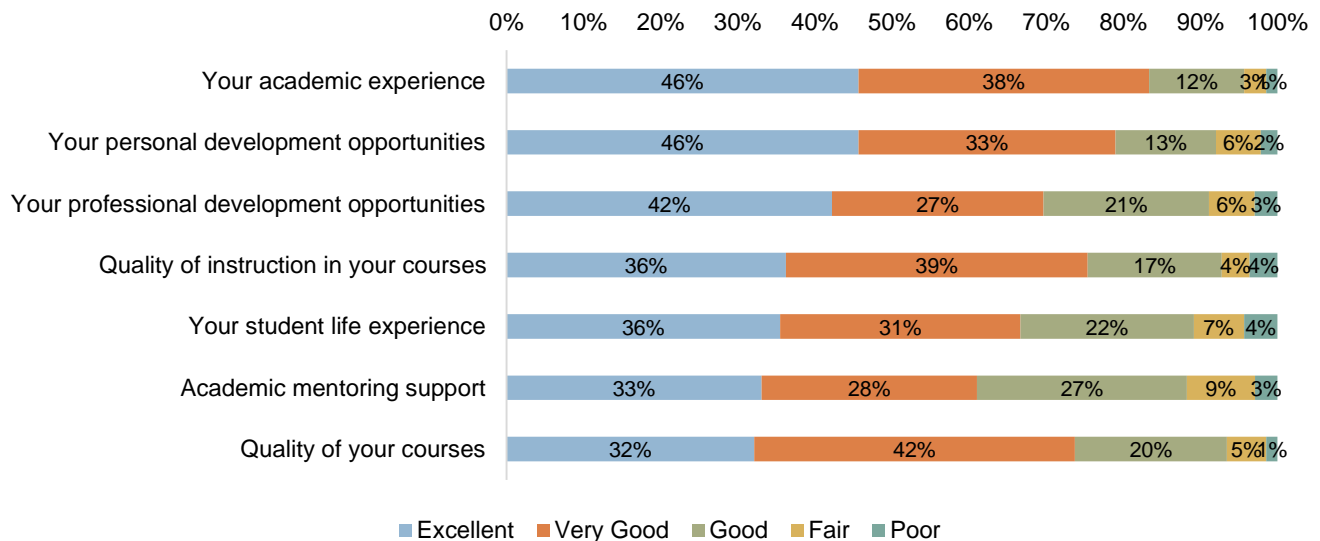

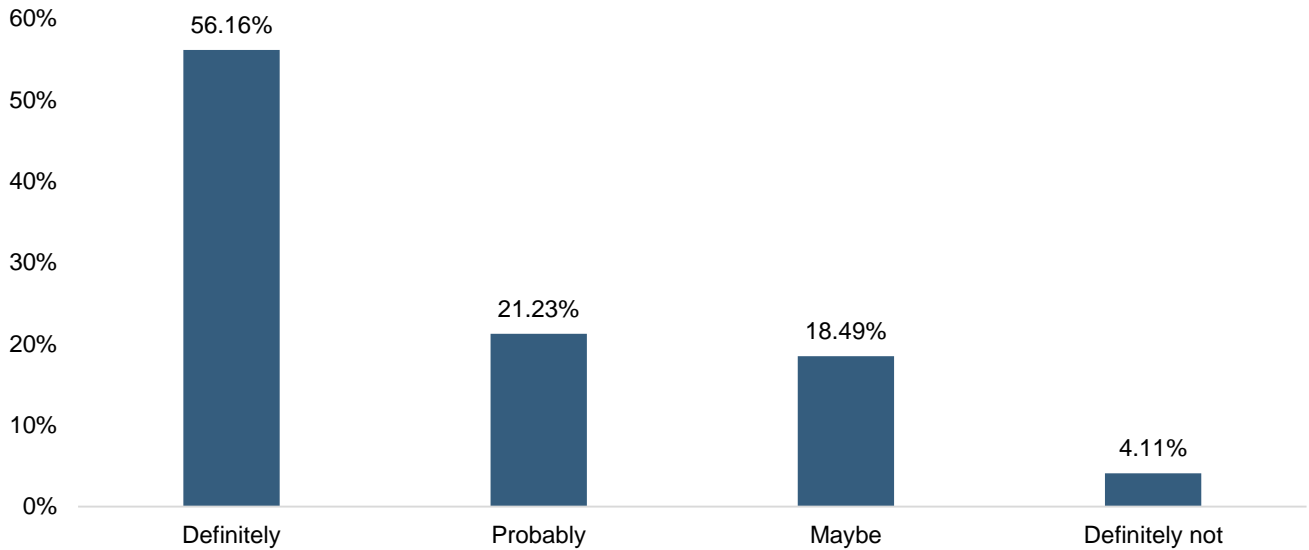
