Attendance

If you decide not to attend the graduation ceremony, undergraduate students should email degreeaudit-ug@aucegypt.edu and graduate students should email gradregis@aucegypt.edu in the Office of the Registrar.

Your name and calling number will be emailed to you via the portal before the rehearsal. If you do not attend the rehearsal your name will be removed from the calling list and you will be able to collect your diploma the following week.

Graduation Admission

The graduation ceremony lasts approximately one hour and a half. Entrance invitations are required; no reserved seating or parking is available for guests.

Please read your invitation to determine the gate you will enter from, as entrance will be allowed only from the gate marked on your invitation.

Arrival Times

You must plan to arrive dressed in your academic attire (cap and gown) and meet one hour before the event. This time aligns with the opening of the outer campus gates and halls. We don't have a secure place for you to store any items you bring with you, so please plan ahead. Please be prompt, and make sure to bring your student invitation with you.

Cap and Gown Group Photo

Commencement Regalia

If you plan to attend the diploma distribution event, you must be attired in a cap and gown. Before you pick up your commencement regalia, an online deposit of EGP 1000 is required for undergraduate students and a deposit of EGP 1150 for graduate students. Visit graduation.aucegypt.edu and fill in the required information. Please make sure to follow the instructions carefully. The tassel is a gift from the University, so you can keep it as a souvenir. If you lose your tassel, you will have to purchase another one.

You may be fitted for a gown in the Conference and Visitor Center, first floor, room 1002, above Bassily Auditorium, on the following dates and times:

You have the choice to retain the cap and gown following the graduation ceremony. Alternatively, should you decide to return it, you will be refunded your deposit with a deduction of EGP 150 for restocking and dry cleaning purposes.

In the event of any damage to the cap and gown, your deposit will be forfeited and utilized to acquire a replacement.

The time to return your commencement regalia is starting March 4 to April 4, 2024 (excluding March 31) from 12 pm to 2 pm on weekdays and 9 am to 4 pm on Fridays and Saturdays.
