Backup and Restore Moodle Courses

Create Course Backup

- After accessing a course from your Moodle Main page, click on Backup under the Settings Block
- 2. Follow the backup wizard:
 - a. Under **Initial Settings**: you can include some or all of the backup options listed except the enrolled users, click **Next** to continue
 - b. Under **Schema Settings**: all your course materials will be selected except anything related to user data. Select all or some, then click **Next**
 - c. **Under Confirmation and Review:** Moodle lists all backup content, and includes the backup file name. you can modify the file name if you wish. Click **Perform Backup**
 - d. After Performing Backup, the final tab will appear confirming that the backup file was successfully created. Click **Continue**
 - e. From this page, you can manage your backup files, save it to your machine, flash memory, or external drive.
 - f. Under User Private Backup area, click Download, and save the file on your machine.

Restore Course Backup

- 1. When your new semester courses are uploaded on your account. All courses appear to be empty.
- 2. Choose the course you wish to restore your previous content into.
- 3. Click **Restore** under the **Settings** block
- 4. Click Choose a file, click Upload a File, and browse your machine for your backed up Moodle course that you wish to restore
- 5. Click Upload this file
- 6. Click the Restore Button, and a wizard will appear. Click Continue to confirm
- 7. Under Restore to this course, choose either to Merge the backup course into this course, or delete any existing content first then restore. Click Continue.
- 8. Follow the wizard and click Next, Next, then Perform Restore, then Continue
